Paula also mentioned her meeting with attorney, Mary Klass, who has advised us regarding non profit group status. We will have to report quarterly, and have no one drawing wages from the club funds. We are planning to purchase the SwimMeet software; no definite plans have been made yet. If we could have a group sponsor who currently owns the software, we can save about \$100 on the purchase. Paula will ask Vicki Gilson of the Ashwaubenon swim club if they would sponsor us.

Sarah Tracy will be going to her reserve training from June 8 to 19 (tentatively). As swim club practice will begin on Monday, June 12, Melissa Barth will be here to get it going in Sarah's absence.

There was some discussion about recruiting more boys into the swim club. Some parents have expressed a desire for a boys high school swim team and are asking if that might become a reality. We will continue discussion of this issue and determine best advertisement for our summer session of the swim club.
