

Seymour Community Swim Club Meeting

Monday, November 12, 2007

The meeting was called to order by Paula Weyers. Minutes from last meeting were available and accepted.

The treasurer's report was given as a balance of \$4,682.79.

The winter session dates will be from November 12, 2007 to February 29, 2008. It is noted that the session will have a break interim from December 14 to January 4 breaking the session into two terms. Practice sessions will be from 3:15 to 5:00 pm on Tuesdays, Thursdays, and Fridays. Lara Eslinger will be coaching the winter session with help from Cal Rastall. He has volunteered to help out when Lara is unavailable. Additionally, high school students will be assisting.

Meet is scheduled on Saturday, December 8, 2007 at Wittenberg. Participants will be informed of the warm up time. January 19, 2008 will be the Iola invite which will include Brillion. Thus far, 12 swimmers have registered, 9 of them being new to the club. We anticipate additional registration on the first day of practice. Additionally, 5 children will be doing a swim test to determine if their participation would be appropriate

Discussion continued about the sale of concessions during swim lesson sign up. Potential date is December 19. No definite plans have yet been made.

Bob Belter presented information about the computer that he feels would work for us and be congruent with our needs. Some discussion continued. Price would be approximately \$1179.00. We will need to buy some computer application disks to allow the Meet software to run with Vista. Paula Weyers motioned to purchase the computer and disks, and Pam Meulemans seconded the motion. Vote was yes.

Clarification was made regarding coaching. They will be offered a stipend for helping; we will not be paying a salary. Decision regarding amount will be deferred to later in the season.
