The meeting was called to order at 6:37 pm by President Paula Weyers. Minutes from last meeting were available.

We may use parents as supervisors during practice as needed, and the club will continue to actively seek coaches/helpers. Joan Sachs, parent, has offered to help with some of the practices. There was also discussion about our high school swim team members choosing dates to possibly help out with practices.

Our non profit status is probably to go through in one week. None of our coaches receive compensation or salary for their time; we may give gifts or donations in thanks.

Mention made of possibility of having swim practice on Fridays in January during swim lesson weeks.
