Minutes and current financial report read and accepted.

Our current financial balance is \$2182.80

We finalized discussion regarding banquet from winter swim session to be held on Monday, May 8 at 6:00 pm in the high school commons area. Invitations will be sent out and the club survey will be printed on the back of the invitation. Members will be asked to return the survey at the banquet. The club will provide napkins, utensils, and beverages; with the food being provided by the members as a potluck.

Registration for the summer swim session will take place concurrently with the swim lesson sign up. This will be held on Tuesday, May 2 from 7:00pm to 9:00 pm. Help is needed with manning the table. Those interested should contact Paula Weyers. Our summer session costs will be as follows: One child \$40, Two children per family-\$75, and \$110 for 3 children per family. A \$5 discount will be given for children who are currently members of the Seymour Community Swim Club. We will also be at the non-district registration time on Tuesday, May 16 from 6:00 pm to 7:00 pm.

Our summer practices will be Monday through Friday from 10:00 am to 12:00 pm from June 12 until June 30; and then 12:00 pm to 2:00 pm from July 6 until August 4. We have one day, June 17, open for a swim meet to be held here at our facility. Meets are still being determined and will be announced at a later date.

There was discussion about setting up a work schedule to sell ice cream treats, water, soda, and candy bars after the summer swimming lesson sessions. This would take place on the last day of each session. These dates would include: June 23, June 28, July 28, and August 11. Sign up will be at our banquet.

Sarah Tracy gave an estimate figure of \$450 needed to purchase equipment needed for our club. She will have a more detailed list and prices so that we can decide on those things at our next meeting.

We are still waiting for word from the Ashwaubenon Swim Club as to whether they will sponsor us so that we can have the discount offered with the Swim Software purchase. Paula is checking on the status of their decision.

Sarah also noted that she will be inviting a former teammate of hers to help with the club. His name is Sean Anday, and he has been sub teaching here at Seymour. She will keep us updated.
