Minutes from June meeting are still outstanding.

Coaching – Paula and Sarah met with Kim to talk about coaching options. Melissa will take the coaching hours when she is scheduled to work. This will include all but 6 hours of the scheduled swim club time. Melissa has submitted a request for \$10 compensation for the time not covered by the pool. Carrie Gorges made a motion to approve the \$10 hourly wage for Melissa. Second to the motion was made by Pam. Vote was taken and was unanimously approved.

The website will be updated with a notice that we are looking for a coach. Sarah will be leaving in August and will be gone for 1 year. We will need a coach for this fall/winter session and the 2007 summer session. We will also put an ad in the paper and a notice up in the Aquatic Center office window. Pay for this new coach will be discussed at that time. The winter session will run from approximately November 13<sup>th</sup> through the end of February, possibly into March.

Meets - There is a meet scheduled at Plymouth on Tuesday, July 12<sup>th</sup> and another meet in Seymour versus Plymouth on Saturday, July 22<sup>nd</sup>. Wayne and Sarah will be driving to the meet in Plymouth. We need volunteers to help run the meet at Seymour. Please contact Paula Weyers or Sarah Tracy. We have received the software and will attempt to have it ready to use for this meet. We will also have a triangular meet at Brillion versus Brillion and Valdars on Saturday July 29<sup>th</sup>. Check the website for more information.

Fundraisers - a work schedule to sell ice cream treats, water, soda, and candy bars after the summer swimming lesson sessions has been created. We need volunteers for each session. These dates would include: June 23, June 28, July 28, and August 11.

We will also make up a sign to advertise the Pizza Hut cards we have remaining. This will be put up in the Aquatic office and displayed during the ice cream sale.

Equipment – Sarah provided a list of equipment and prices for things the club could consider buying. The items and counts include:

The total cost of these items would be approximately \$465.75. Wayne Meulemans made a motion to purchase the kick boards and pull bouys. Second to the motion was made by Pam. Vote was taken and was unanimously approved. Paula will contact All American Aquatics to discuss.

Other items – Hamburger Day Float – the theme of the event is Hamburger Charlies Round-Up. Carrie looked into pencils to be printed with the swim club name/website. They are \$4.95 for 24. This is too expensive. Steve and Paula looked into ice pops. They are 200 for \$6.97. It was decided to hand these out.

- 3 Water Warriors are helping Hamburger Charlies round up
- 4 Round up the Water Warriors
- 5 Water Warriors are riding the waves to the Round up

The float could have sea horses. Bob will find some seahorse examples and send them to Paula. The club members will ride the float wearing cowboy hats. Steve and Paula will get a wagon. The float will be built at Steve and Paula's house during the week of July 31<sup>st</sup> to August 4<sup>th</sup>.

Steve Weyers made a motion to do a float for the parade. Second to the motion was made by Wayne. A vote was taken and was unanimously approved.

Steve W. made a motion to adjourn. Second to the motion was made by Wayne M. The meeting adjourned at 7:45 pm.
